

Greater Houston Soap Box Derby (GHSBD) presents...

Gravity Racing Events at Hockley Derby Park *a Harris County Pct. 4 Park*

GRAVITY RACING: A "Family Team" Activity which consists of kids and adults. Car handling is part of this team activity, which involves lifting cars on and off trailers, positioning them in the starting gates and moving them out of the braking area once they have come to a complete stop.

NOTE: Derby cars are provided by Pct. 4 and maintained by GHSBD.

COMMON RULES:

Minimum Age - Kids entering the first grade during the current race season can race in our events as long as they will turn 7 sometime during the school year.

Underage Kids - Ages 6 and under attending Public Fun Days can ride in a dual seat car with an experienced driver provided (subject to approval by race officials).

Driver Training - Basic training is provided for all first time participants (kids & adults) at Fun Days and Sr. Adult races. Kids racing in our NDR rally races and must have previously completed a New Driver Training session to be eligible to drive a fully weighted car in a rally race.

Helmets - The type of helmet we use is a standard DOT approved bicycle helmet. For Super Kids, New Driver Training, Fun Day Events and "Zero" Gravity Derby it's up to parents to determine the type of helmet their child needs for their safety. For our NDR Rallies the helmets must be an Official AASBD Helmet. We do have helmets available at all our events but suggest you bring your own with name attached.

General Admission - There is no cost to spectators, grandstand seating provided and a concession stand is available at most events (cash only) or bring your own food and drinks.

- No skateboards, scooters, ball / frisbee throwing allowed at derby park during an event.
- No smoking allowed.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed.

IMPORTANT: ALL PARTICIPANTS must fill-out and sign the County Release Form on next page and bring to event.

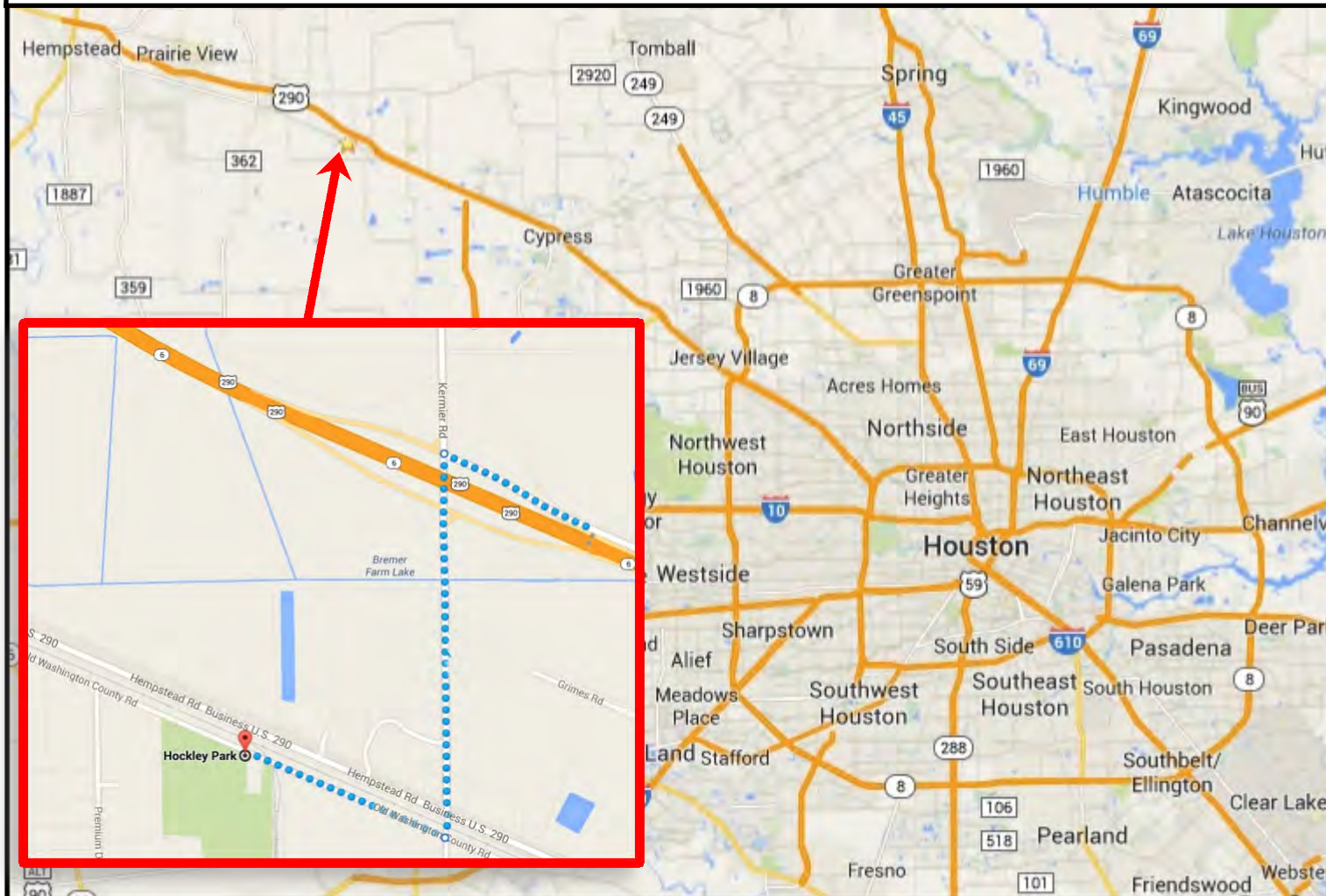

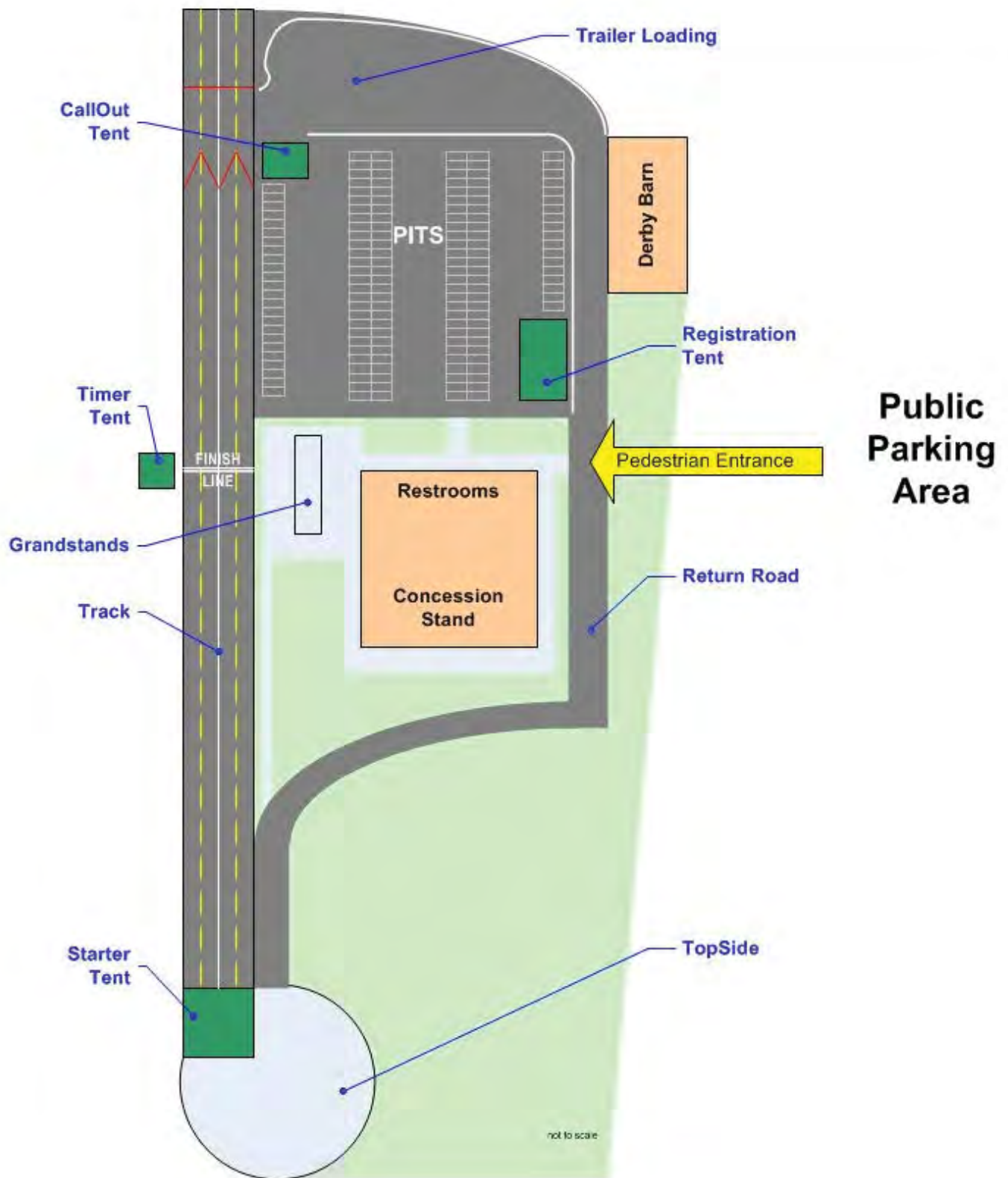

"Zero" Gravity Derby

A Match-Your-Own-Time Race for Kids & Adults

"Zero" Gravity Derby is a fun, fast-paced racing event that promotes competitive racing, driving skills, safe braking and self-improvement. Participants try to match their own Elapsed Time (ET), which is the time it takes to get from the starting gates to the finish line.

Derby Cars: Stock, Super Stock, and Pro Stock/Adult cars provided by Greater Houston Soap Box Derby (GHSBD). Or participants may bring their own official AASBD kit car or a modified kit with **NO WEIGHTS ADDED** or a "Run What You Brung Car" (all cars must pass safety inspection).

Race Requirements: Must meet the Minimum Age (see website) and previously had a GHSBD driver training session. All participants must wear foot protection and a DOT approved helmet.

Cost \$10: Participants will receive a minimum of 2 heats (4 runs down the hill).

How it works...

Heats: Two runs down the hill in the same lane define a single "heat." The 1st run sets the ET that drivers will try to match on their 2nd run. Once drivers finish their 1st run, they will immediately be sent back up the hill to make their 2nd ET run, thus completing their heat.

Penalty Points: A time of .01 second will be added to the sum total for each lane violation. A lane violation occurs when a derby car's wheel touches a lane line before the car comes to a complete stop. The lane lines are the solid white lines on the left and right that define each lane. The option of a do-over for a run will be given to any participant that has their run impeded by another driver crossing into their lane before the finish line.

Race Scoring: The subtracted ET sum total of a single heat plus any penalty points is your "Score" for that heat. Your lowest heat score determines your race ranking. The racer's "Score" that comes closest to ZERO is the overall winner. If there are any ties in determining the top 3 places, their 2 lowest lane heat scores will be averaged to determine their place (an additional heat maybe needed).

Awards: 1st through 3rd place will receive trophies and prizes.
